





GUEST INFORMATION



MURCHISON FALLS NATIONAL PARK

We are approximately a 15 min drive to Murchison Falls National Park. It is well worth a visit. Murchison Falls National Park is a truly special place and one of Uganda's most loved natural treasures. The park is famous for the dramatic Murchison Falls, where the River Nile squeezes through a narrow rocky gap before crashing down in a spectacular rush of water. It's an impressive sight and a wonderful reminder of the power and beauty of nature.

The park is home to an incredible variety of wildlife and landscapes. As you explore, you may see elephants, giraffes, buffalo, antelope and, if you're lucky, lions or leopards resting in the shade. Along the Nile, hippos and crocodiles are easy to spot, and bird lovers will enjoy the many colourful and unique bird species that live in the park, including the rare shoebill.

There are many relaxed and enjoyable ways to experience the park. A gentle boat cruise on the Nile brings you close to wildlife along the riverbanks and takes you right to the base of the falls, while game drives offer classic safari views and photo opportunities.

For those who enjoy walking, a guided hike to the top of the falls provides beautiful views and a memorable experience. Murchison Falls National Park is a highlight of any stay in the area, and we are happy to help you plan your visit.



ENTRANCE FEES AND COSTS

All visitors are required to show their valid identification documents.

Fees are for 24 hours from entry, any time spent inside the park will be charged as an extra day.

Entrance fees do not include visiting the falls.
